Canadian coach Ghislain Briand is one of figure skating's most prestigious jump specialists, known globally for his technical mastery and engaging coaching style. Briand rose to prominence coaching two-time Olympic silver medalist Elvis Stojko until 2001. He then spent many successful years at Toronto's Cricket and Curling Club, partnering closely with Brian Orser and coaching Japanese superstar Yuzuru Hanyu to two Olympic gold medals.

Recently, Briand embarked on a new chapter, now collaborating with Stéphane Lambiel at the Skating School of Switzerland. With more than forty years of coaching experience, Briand emphasizes rhythm, direction, and body alignment as key principles for perfecting jumps. He advocates strongly for athlete health, prioritizing injury prevention in training, and supports thoughtful approaches to athletic development, such as recent age-limit changes in competition.

Known for bringing humor and enjoyment into training sessions, Briand believes a positive atmosphere helps skaters perform at their best. He continues to inspire athletes and is excited to contribute further to their development in the upcoming seasons.
